CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU

Opulent, creamy and expansive, this white fills the mouth, offering peach, apple, quinine and salty mineral flavors embraced by vanilla and toasty oak notes. There's a tactile sensation, and this still lacks integration, yet all of the components are there, along with power and length. Best from 2027 through 2042. 3,800 cases made, 1,400 cases imported. –BS

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "LA GARENNE"

A sleek, tense white, exhibiting apple, lemon, stone and baking spice flavors. Balanced in a linear way, leaving a chalky sensation on the multidimensional aftertaste. Kicks into high gear at the end. Best from 2027 through 2035. 100 cases made, 40 cases imported. –BS



PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "LES CHALUMEAUX"

Rich, creamy and intensely flavored, offering peach, apple tart, vanilla and butterscotch flavors. A lemon note emerges as this white builds to the long finish. Balanced and consistent from beginning to end. Drink now through 2032. 150 cases made, 40 cases imported. –BS

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "LES REFERTS"

Shows richness, along with peach, lemon curd, butterscotch and toasted brioche flavors, all cut by bracing acidity. In the end, this white merges into the focused aftertaste of lemon and spices. Drink now through 2029. 120 cases made, 50 cases imported. –BS

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "SOUS LE PUITS"

Plush yet dense, displaying **peach**, **apple**, **vanilla** and **nutmeg** aromas and flavors. Underlined by solid acidity, this just tails off a little on the finish. The oak spice notes linger. Best from 2027 through 2033. 1,250 cases made, 350 cases imported. –BS

MEURSAULT-GENEVRIERES 1ER CRU

This is plump and exudes peach, apricot and toasty oak flavors. Clove and nutmeg accents emerge as this plays out on the tense finish. Long yet subtle and balanced, with a lingering mineral element. Best from 2026 through 2035. 170 cases made, 50 cases imported. –BS

MEURSAULT GOUTTE D'OR 1ER CRU

Lemon tart, vanilla and toasty oak aromas and flavors are aligned with a vibrant structure in this graceful white. Focused and intense in a self-confident way, this lingers on the mouthwatering aftertaste. Drink now through 2030. 400 cases made, 100 cases imported.

BEAUNE

A seamless, polished white, featuring apple, lemon and baking spice flavors. Open and verges on creamy in texture before the vibrant acidity refreshes the mineral-tinged finish. Shows terrific harmony and length. Drink now through 2030. 360 cases made, 100 cases imported. –BS

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "LA GRANDE MONTAGNE"

Peach, apple tart and butterscotch flavors hold court in this fluid white. Balanced, with a tangy feel on the finish. Delivers consistency and length, along with a plump profile. Drink now through 2029. 240 cases made, 60 cases imported. –BS

MEURSAULT-BLAGNY 1er Cru Château de Blagny

Fresh, juicy and expressive, this white delivers **peach**, **apple**, **floral**, **honey** and baking spice aromas and flavors. Balanced, charming and enticing, with terrific balance and fine length. Drink now through 2029. 1,900 cases made, 510 cases imported. –BS

BEAUNE 1ER CRU AUX CRAS

This is creamy and displays **peach**, **apple pie** and **honey** flavors, plus a hint of **quinine**. A **butterscotch** note emerges as this plays out on the long, spicy finish. Offers fine balance and punch overall. Drink now through 2029. 140 cases made, 40 cases imported. –BS

SAINT-AUBIN 1ER CRU

This white ranges from peach to lemon in its flavors, shaded by baking spices and a hint of the seashore. Round and supple, this ends with juicy acidity driving the citrus- and spice-infused finish. Drink now through 2029. 250 cases made, 40 cases imported. –BS

DOMAINE LATOUR PELLATION CORTON CONTROLÉE

Corton Domaine Latour Grand Cru 2023

An opulent red, this is saturated with cherry, blackberry, plum, earth, iron and smoky oak spice aromas and flavors. Dense and firms up on the finish, with a solid grip of tannins. Lively acidity also keep this well-defined and long. Best from 2028 through 2047.—B.S.

VOLNAY

This red is rich and silky, offering smoky cherry and raspberry fruit. There's an underlying mineral element and well-integrated tannins, leaving a fine equilibrium. The fruit-, earth- and sandalwood-tinged finish is driven by lively acidity.

Drink now through 2038.



BEAUNE 1ER CRU VIGNES FRANCHES

Well-marked by **sweet**, **spicy oak**, this red also displays **blackberry**, **chocolate** and **bitter almond** flavors. Tips toward the **tannins**, leaving the finish lightly **astringent**. A bit jumbled today, yet there's ripeness and an elegant feel.

Best from 2028 through 2042.



BEAUNE 1ER CRU Clos du Roi

A bright, cherry- and blackberry-infused red, with a fluid feel. Notes of charred oak, sweet spices and earth add interest, but in the end, sinewy tannins rule the finish.

Best from 2028 through 2039.

PERNAND-VERGELESSES 1ER CRU ILES DES VERGELESSES

An expression of **cherry** and **raspberry** is wrapped in **smoky oak**. **Stony mineral** and **tomato leaf** flavors add depth as this red firms up on the dry, chalky finish. Juicy and long.

Best from 2027 through 2037.
