CORTON CHÂTEAU CORTON GRANCEY GRAND CRU 2022

Rich and spicy, this red features ample **cherry, raspberry, rose hip** and **stony mineral** flavors. Silky, yet with a fine underpinning of refined tannins, ending in a resonant aftertaste. The terrific harmony, structure and length signal its future potential. Best from 2027 through 2045.

CHAMBERTIN CUVÉE HÉRITIERS LATOUR GRAND CRU 2022

Packed with **ripe cherry, raspberry, pomegranate** and **spice** aromas and flavors, this red is complex and sophisticated. A mineral current also courses throughout, while the supple texture and refined tannins add to its overall balance and appeal. Best from 2029 through 2047.

CORTON -PERRIÈRES GRAND CRU 2022

Though succulent, there's density, power and structure informing this beefy red. **Black cherry, blackberry, earth, iron, vanilla** and **toasty oak** flavors are wrapped in a cloak of ripe tannins, lending a wild, almost savage feel. The finish is compact today, yet this will be fine in 5–7 years. Best from 2028 through 2048.

CORTON CLOS DU ROI GRAND CRU 2022

Rich and succulent, like biting into a **crunchy cherry**, this red also delivers **blackberry, violet, stone** and **earth** accents. Lithe and well-delineated, firming up on the long, tightly wound finish. Though more about the minerals and structure in the end, this is balanced and full of energy. Best from 2028 through 2047.

CORTON CLOS DE LA VIGNE AU SAINT GRAND CRU 2022

There's fine purity to the **juicy, ripe cherry, raspberry, rose** and **rich earth** aromas and flavors of this red. An underlying **mineral** component adds depth and dimension as this builds to the long, complex aftertaste. Harmony and elegance are its hallmarks, with a silky texture and excellent length. Best from 2027 through 2047.
