CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU

Open and aromatic with honeysuckle flowers, dried apples and mangoes, as well as white peaches and stone. Full-bodied, this grows slowly on the palate with an intense, powerful finish. Lots of cream, cooked apples, lemons and light oak at the very end. Tight and right. Try after 2023.

BÂTARD-MONTRACHET GRAND CRU

The aromas of hot stones in the vineyard really highlight the dried apples and citrus with flint and straw, following to a full body with a tight palate and reserved finish. It needs time to open and show it's greatness. Give it three to four years to open.

MONTRACHET Grand Cru

A magnificent white with such great depth of fruit and super intensity, showing flint, stone, nutmeg, thyme and light lemon rind. It's so full with deep, deep depth that brings you down through the wine. Lasts for minutes. Needs at least four or five years to show what its full potential. Drink after 2024.

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1er Cru "Les Referts"

A creamy-textured white with lemons, pear drops, light vanilla and hints of green apples. Lively acidity and a steely undertone. Medium to full body. Flavorful finish. Zesty. Drink or hold.

PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1er Cru "Sous le Puits"

A dense, layered white with cooked-apple, honey and light pear aromas and flavors. It's fullbodied and tight with lovely fruit. White pepper and spice. Intense finish. Drink or hold.

CHEVALIER-MONTRACHET GRAND CRU "Les Demoiselles"



There's boldness and energy to this with superb concentration of fruit and density, yet it remains agile and lively with length and drive. The flavors are superbly complex and subtle with ripe-apple, cream, honeysuckle, mineral and hot-stone undertones. Goes on for minutes. This is one for the cellar. Impressive to taste now, but one to try in 2023 and onwards to appretciate its full potential.

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "MORGEOT"



Aromas of cooked apples, dried meat and hot stones. Some honey blossom. It's full-bodied with pretty depth and intensity. Layers of fruit in a complex interplay with smoky wood. Drink or hold.

CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "CAILLERET"



A rich Chassagne with layered ripe apples, honey and stone. It's full-bodied, yet creamy and refined. Some dried-apple and mineral undertones. A candiedlemon and stone aftertaste to the fruit. Drink now.

MEURSAULT



Aromas of ripe apples and lemons with a lavender and honevsuckle undertone. It's fullbodied with lovely firmness and form that gives the wine tension and focus. Hints of hay to the bright fruit in the aftertaste. Drink or hold.

MEURSAULT 1ER CRU "Château de Blagny"

A creamy, round-textured white with cooked-apple and some ripe-peach character. Some melon, too. It's full-bodied with layers of fruit and a soft, fruity finish. Drink now.

MEURSAULT 1ER CRU "PERRIÈRES"

Very pretty palate to this with densely proportioned fruit, offering cooked-apple, honey and lemon-cream flavors. White peaches, too. It's full-bodied with a tense framework. Lively finish. Drinkable now, but better in a year or two.

Sliced lemons and green apples with stone and flint undertones. It's full-bodied and layered with a bitter-lemon highlight at the finish. Drink now.

Lovely sliced apples and pears with some lemon-drop character. Medium body, delicious fruit and bright acidity that frames the wine nicely. Drink or hold.

MARSANNAY BLANC



A lovely white with mango and pineapple character, as well as pear. It's medium-bodied and layered with creamy, softness to the lively finish. Drink now.



A pretty white with dried apples, lemons and light hay and honey. It's medium-to full-bodied with lovely fruit and a fresh, layered finish. Drink now.

MÂCON-LUGNY "LES GENIÈVRES"



This is always a delicious white with apples bananas and some stone undertones. It's full-bodied with a fruity finish. Hints of tropical fruit at the end. Drink now.

Dried strawberries with dried flowers and crushed stones on the nose. So enticing and fascinating. Full-bodied with a compact, tight palate of ripe yet cool and fine fruit. Complex finish of dried spice, such as nutmeg, together with fruit and light earth. A beauty already. Better after 2023.

CORTON GRAND CRU "CLOS DE LA VIGNE AU SAINT

Lovely purity of fruit with crushed berries, dried lemons, mushrooms and cedar undertones. It's full-bodied and layered with soft tannins. Savory and subtly fruity at the same time. Drink after 2022.

A ripe, juicy red with berries and light walnut and hazelnut undertones. Blue fruit, too. Medium to full body. Flavorful finish with chocolate and mushroom undertones to the fruit. Drinkable now, but better after 2022.
